One fun time my nickname was "Champas" in the make-up department because a well known actor gave every girl a name once given that was that. Mine was given partly because he always caught me opening a bottle of Champagne for the end of a series, a drama, someone's birthday etc. This day I had my 8mm movie camera in the make-up departments it was one of the girl's farewell. The Beatles arrived in the middle of this. Ringo took the camera from me, said: "you must get some more exciting shots, like this and this and preceded to shoot until my film ran out with the champagne. Later, when I had to return to Australia, The Bealtes Christmas Special was the last show I supervised. It was a nice present to have them, plus the whole cast, signing my worksheet as a momento of my happy time with the company.
