

Gifts and Benefits

Fourth Quarter of the 2021-22 Financial Year

The Australian Public Service Commission has provided new guidance relating to gifts and benefits for agency heads (including departmental secretaries). These commenced on 18 October 2019 and will see registers published quarterly starting in early 2020. Agency heads (including departmental secretaries) must not accept gifts or benefits which might reasonably be seen to compromise their integrity. All gifts or benefits accepted (and valued at over \$AUD100.00 (excluding GST)), must be publicly disclosed. Agency heads must publish a register of gifts and benefits they accept on their departmental or agency website on a quarterly basis.
